# **OUR PROGRAMME**

The BTI Bachelor of Education (Teaching) Early Childhood Education programme prepares graduate teachers to effectively design and implement holistic, quality education for infants, toddlers, and young children, consistent with a biblical worldview, *Te Whāriki*, and the Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand's *Code of Professional Responsibility and Standards for the Teaching* profession.

The programme's foundational *Conceptual Framework* provides the basis for coherence across courses within the programmes which seek to nurture the hearts, minds, and practice of pre-service educators conducive to developing wise educators who are gracious, secure, and teachable and whose practice is relational, responsive and transformative.



#### **Field-based Learning**

Students choosing to study via the field-based mode of learning commit to a programme where they self-manage their learning programme mostly online from a distance while also spending a minimum of 12 hours per week working in an early learning service in either paid employment or a voluntary capacity. Field-based students are also required to attend a two-week intensive each semester. Throughout the programme students will engage with home centre learning, independent learning, face to face intensives and professional experience placements.
