The SSF applies to both domestic students and international students that pay a fee for student services.

Students through class reps (Student Council) are involved in making decisions with BTI about aspects of the SSF to determine:

- › the maximum fee that students will pay
- › the types of services that will be delivered within the specified categories
- › the procurement and method for authorising expenditure on these services.
