

COMPULSORY STUDENT SERVICES FEE 2020 REPORT

BTI charges students Compulsory Student Services Fee (CSSF) to support the delivery of student services that support students and enhance their academic experience. The CSSF applies to both domestic students and international students that pay a fee for student services.

Students through class reps will be involved in making decisions about aspects of the CSSF. Decisions about CSSF are to be made jointly with BTI to determine:

- › the maximum fee that students will pay
- › the types of services that will be delivered within the specified categories
- › the procurement and method for authorising expenditure on these services.
