#### What do I need?

- A completed NZ Qualifications Authority approved Level 7 bachelor degree (evidence of).
- If no degree, you can submit an essay with your application, and need to successfully complete MPP841 with at least a B grade before progressing.
- For overseas degrees, an International Qualifications Assessment (IQA) for NZQA approved Level 7 equivalency.
- A minimum 2 years' professional experience.

### Professional Practice & Leadership programme

#### MPP 841:

Developing professional **identity** through:

- Scholarship informed by faith, inspired by hope and motivated by love.

#### MPP 842:

Developing professional **practice** through:

- Critical reflection on one's own professional practice
- Consideration of power, privilege, and culture.
- Critical engagement with biblical mandate for social change.
- Reflection on leadership approaches.

Option to exit with a Postgrad Diploma

Master of Professional Practice & Leadership

#### MPP 850

Completing a 60 credit thesis based on an aspect of your own professional practice, including a leadership or leadership development component or focus.

#### MPP 843:

Developing leadership competence through:

- Critical exploration of theoretical leadership models.
- Applying leadership concepts to professional practice.
- Engaging with biblical narratives about leadership.
- Taking responsibility for what we do with what we come to know.

#### MPP 844:

Planning a research project. This includes the opportunity to:

- Evaluate research methods used in research-informed professional practice.
- Engage with principles and practices of research ethics.
- Learn to critically review current literature.
- Gain confidence and competence in writing at a publishable level.

# How do I apply?

Application process for Master of Professional Practice and Leadership programme

You submit an application online



You are notified that your application has been received and referee(s) are emailed by the administrator requesting a reference form to be completed.

Administrator contacts you to arrange an interview – Administrator arranges interview between yourself and the interviewer(s)



Administrator receives outcome of interview

If successful: You are offered place of studentship

You accept studentship

Administrator hands over application to the programme administrator to start enrolment process

You must supply all necessary documentation required by BTI before your application can be completed.
